



Cultivated Area of Autumn Cabbages and Radishes in 2023

- ☐ The cultivated area of autumn cabbages decreased by 5.7% from 13,953ha in 2022 to 13,152ha in 2023.
- O The cultivated area of autumn cabbages recorded a year-on-year decrease owing to the drop in cabbage prices during the July-September period.
- ☐ The cultivated area of autumn radishes fell by 5.0% from 6,340ha in 2022 to 6,026ha in 2023.
- O The cultivated area of autumn radishes recorded a year-on-year decrease owing to the drop in radish prices during the July-September period.



1. Cultivated area of autumn cabbages

The cultivated area of autumn cabbages fell by 802ha (-5.7%) from 13,953ha in 2022 to 13,152ha in 2023.

- The cultivated area of autumn cabbages recorded a year-on-year decrease owing to the drop in cabbage prices during the July-September period.
- Cabbage prices between July and September (Source: Korea Agricultural Marketing Information Service, wholesale prices of high-quality cabbages per kg)
 - * 1,033 won in 2019 \rightarrow 1,910 won in 2020 \rightarrow 1,040 won in 2021 \rightarrow 2,298 won in 2022 \rightarrow 1,501 won in 2023

< Cultivated area of autumn cabbages >





As for the cultivated area of autumn cabbages by region, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure of 3,100ha, which was followed by Chungbuk (2,213ha), Gyeongbuk (2,144ha), Gangwon (1,687ha) and Chungnam (1,072ha).



2. Cultivated area of autumn radishes

The cultivated area of autumn radishes declined by 314ha (-5.0%) from 6,340ha in 2022 to 6,026ha in 2023.

- The cultivated area of autumn radishes recorded a year-on-year decrease owing to the drop in radish prices during the July-September period.
- Radish prices between July and September (Source: Korea Agricultural Marketing Information Service, wholesale prices of high-quality radishes per kg)
 - * 530 won in 2019 \rightarrow 967 won in 2020 \rightarrow 620 won in 2021 \rightarrow 1,311 won in 2022 \rightarrow 969 won in 2023

< Cultivated area of autumn radishes >





As for the cultivated area of autumn radishes by region, Jeonbuk recorded the highest figure of 1,289ha, which was followed by Chungnam (1,031ha), Jeonnam (831ha), Gyeonggi (822ha) and Gangwon (601ha).
