

## Livestock Statistics in the Second Quarter of 2023


☐ In the second quarter of 2023, the number of layers and broilers recorded a year-on-year increase. Whereas, the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle', dairy cattle, pigs and ducks recorded a year-on-year decrease.

#### < Livestock statistics in the second quarter of 2023 >




- ☐ The number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle' amounted to 3.686 million in the second quarter of 2023. This figure fell by 48 thousand (-1.3%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but rose by 54 thousand (1.5%) from the previous quarter.
- ☐ The number of dairy cattle totaled 383 thousand in the second quarter of 2023. This figure dropped by 5 thousand (-1.4%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 2 thousand (-0.6%) from the previous quarter.
- ☐ The number of pigs was 11.108 million in the second quarter of 2023. This figure declined by 58 thousand (-0.5%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 2 thousand (0.0%) from the previous quarter.

### < Trends in the number of 'Korean native cattle and beef cattle', dairy cattle and pigs >



- ☐ The number of layers amounted to 75.19 million in the second quarter of 2023. This figure rose by 2.117 million (2.9%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 1.506 million (2.0%) from the previous quarter.
- ☐ The number of broilers totaled 110.869 million in the second quarter of 2023. This figure grew by 4.615 million (4.3%) from the same quarter of the previous year and 22.017 million (24.8%) from the previous quarter.
- ☐ The number of ducks totaled 8.816 million in the second quarter of 2023. This figure dropped by 947 thousand (-9.7%) from the same quarter of the previous year, but rose by 3.994 million (82.8%) from the previous quarter.
