


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Preliminary Results of 2019 Census on Establishments

Number of establishments and workers

□ Compared to the previous year, the number of establishments and workers grew by 1.8% and 2.2%, respectively.

- O As of the end of 2019, the number of establishments was 4.175 million entities, which increased by 1.8% (72 thousand entities) from a year ago. The number of workers was 22.717 million persons, which rose by 2.2% (482 thousand persons) from a year ago.
- Compared to a decade ago, the number of establishments went up by 26.8% (882 thousand entities) and the number of workers grew by 35.1% (5.899 million persons).
 - For the past decade (2009~2019), the number of establishments and workers grew by 2.4% and 3.1%, respectively, on an annual average.



< Number of establishments and workers by year >



2 Number of establishments by industry

☐ Most of industries (excluding 'Mining and Quarrying') recorded an increase in establishments.

Compared to the previous year, as for establishments by industry, 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' recorded the highest increase (19 thousand entities, 2.5%), which was followed by 'Transportation and Storage' (9 thousand entities, 2.2%) and 'Real Estate Activities' (8 thousand entities, 5.3%). In the meantime, 'Mining and Quarrying' decreased by 139 entities (-7.3%).



□ All industries (excluding 'Mining and Quarrying') recorded an increase in workers.

Compared to the previous year, as for workers by industry, 'Human Health and Social Work Activities' (129 thousand persons, 6.8%), 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' (58 thousand persons, 2.5%) and 'Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities' (56 thousand persons, 5.2%) marked an increase. Whereas, 'Mining and Quarrying' (-108 persons, -0.7%) marked a decrease.


Number of establishments and workers by type of legal organization

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
□ Compared to the previous year, individual establishments recorded an increase (31 thousand entities) in establishments. Non-company corporations recorded an increase (179 thousand persons) in workers.

Compared to the previous year, as for establishments by type of legal organization, individual establishments (31 thousand entities, 0.9%) recorded the highest increase, which was followed by company corporations (30 thousand entities, 5.1%).

Compared to the previous year, as for workers by type of legal organization, non-company corporations (179 thousand persons, 5.3%) recorded the highest increase, which was followed by individual establishments (138 thousand persons, 1.7%) and company corporations (85 thousand persons, 0.9%).



Number of establishments and workers by size of workers

 Compared to the previous year, establishments with 1 ~ 4 workers recorded an increase in establishments (48 thousand entities). Establishments with 5 ~ 99 workers recorded an increase in workers (229 thousand persons).

Compared to the previous year, as for establishments by size of workers, establishments with 1 ~ 4 workers (48 thousand entities, 1.5%) recorded the highest increase, which was followed by establishments with 5 ~ 99 workers (24 thousand entities, 3.0%).

Compared to the previous year, as for workers by size of workers, establishments with 5 ~ 99 workers (229 thousand persons, 2.1%) recorded the highest increase, which was followed by establishments with 1 ~ 4 workers (161 thousand persons, 2.7%).




☐ As for workers by status of workers, regular workers showed the highest year-on-year increase.

Compared to the previous year, as for workers by status of workers, regular workers recorded the highest increase (314 thousand persons, 2.2%), which was followed by temporary and daily workers (108 thousand persons, 3.7%), self-employed and unpaid family workers (52 thousand persons, 1.3%) and other workers (9 thousand persons, 0.9%).



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< Composition of workers by status of workers / Increase and increase rate in workers > orkers by status of workers >



Number of establishments by age group of CEOs

- □ Establishments with a CEO aged 50 ~ 59 occupied the largest share. Compared to the previous year, establishments with a CEO aged 60 or more recorded the highest increase.
- \bigcirc As of the end of 2019, establishments with a CEO aged 50 ~ 59 occupied the largest share at 34.6%, which was followed by establishments with a CEO aged 40 ~ 49 (27.1%) and establishments with a CEO aged 60 or more (23.0%).
- As for the year-on-year percent change in establishments by age group of CEOs, establishments with a CEO aged 60 or more recorded the highest increase (35 thousand entities, 3.7%), which was followed by establishments with a CEO aged 50 ~ 59 (28 thousand entities, 1.9%) and establishments with a CEO aged 29 or less (5 thousand entities, 4.5%).

8 Number of establishments with a female CEO by industry

- Compared to the previous year, the female CEOs recorded a rise in 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities', 'Membership Organizations, Repair and Other Personal Services' and 'Education'.
- Accommodation and Food Service Activities', 'Education' and 'Membership Organizations, Repair and Other Personal Services' showed a higher share of female CEOs compared to the average of all industries.
- As for establishments with a female CEO, 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' recorded the highest year-on-year increase (6 thousand entities, 1.3%), which was followed by 'Membership Organizations, Repair and Other Personal Services' (6 thousand entities, 3.0%) and 'Education' (4 thousand entities, 3.5%).
- As of the end of 2019, 'Accommodation and Food Service Activities' (59.9%), 'Education' (57.3%) and 'Membership Organizations, Repair and Other Personal Service' (48.7%) showed a higher share of female CEOs compared to the average of all industries (38.5%).





- Compared to the previous year, Gyeonggi recorded the highest increase in workers (128 thousand persons, 2.5%), which was followed by Chungnam (46 thousand persons, 4.9%), Jeonnam (40 thousand persons, 5.5%), Gyeongnam (39 thousand persons, 2.8%) and Gyeongbuk (32 thousand persons, 2.9%).
