○ In 2022, the number of export enterprises was 95,015, rising by 0.4% from 2021. In 2022, the number of import enterprises was 206,329, falling by 1.6% from 2021.

□ [Number of enterprises]

- In 2022, the total number of export enterprises rose by 0.4% from 2021. The number of middle standing enterprises decreased by 1.8%. Whereas, the number of 'Large enterprises' and 'Small and medium-sized enterprises' rose by 0.4% and 0.5%, respectively.
- In 2022, the total number of import enterprises fell by 1.6% from 2021. The number of large enterprises rose by 7.3%. Whereas, the number of 'Middle standing enterprises' and 'Small and medium-sized enterprises' dropped by 2.9% and 1.6%, respectively.

☐ [International trade value]

- Ocompared to 2021, the export value of large enterprises increased by 6.0% to 444.7 billion dollars in 2022. The export value of middle standing enterprises grew by 11.8% to 124.0 billion dollars in 2022. The export value of small and medium-sized enterprises grew by 0.5% to 113.3 billion dollars in 2022.
- Ocompared to 2021, the import value of large enterprises increased by 27.9% to 454.6 billion dollars in 2022. The import value of middle standing enterprises grew by 10.7% to 113.3 billion dollars in 2022. The import value of small and medium-sized enterprises grew by 5.0% to 155.7 billion dollars in 2022.

International trade by industry

□ [Number of enterprises]

- The total number of export enterprises rose by 0.4% year-on-year owing to the increase in 'Wholesale and retail trade' (1.4%) and 'Other industries' (2.9%) in spite of the decrease in 'Mining and manufacturing' (-1.3%).
- The total number of import enterprises decreased by 1.6% year-on-year due to the drop in 'Mining and manufacturing' (-2.3%), 'Wholesale and retail trade' (-1.4%) and 'Other industries' (-0.7%).

☐ [International trade value]

- The total export value grew by 6.1% year-on-year owing to the increase in 'Mining and manufacturing' (5.2%), 'Wholesale and retail trade' (10.2%) and 'Other industries' (13.9%).
- The total import value grew by 19.4% year-on-year owing to the increase in 'Mining and manufacturing' (19.9%), 'Wholesale and retail trade' (4.0%) and 'Other industries'* (57.0%).
 - * In particular, 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' showed a year-on-year increase in import value.

- The export enterprises with '1~9 employees' rose by 1.2% year-on-year. In the meantime, the export enterprises with '10~49 employees', '50~249 employees' and '250 employees or more' declined by 1.2%, 0.6% and 1.6%, respectively, from 2021.
- The import enterprises with '1~9 employees', '10~49 employees', '50~249 employees' and '250 employees or more' dropped by 1.3%, 2.8%, 1.3% and 0.2%, respectively, from 2021.

- The export value of enterprises with '1~9 employees', '50~249 employees' and '250 employees or more' grew by 4.5%, 12.9% and 5.9%, respectively, from 2021. Whereas, the export value of enterprises with '10~49 employees' declined by 4.3% from 2021.
- The import value of enterprises with '1~9 employees', '10~49 employees', '50~249 employees' and '250 employees or more' grew by 7.3%, 4.3%, 5.6% and 26.2%, respectively, from 2021.

The share of export value of top 10 enterprises stood at 35.6% in 2022, up 0.1%p from 2021. The share of export value of top 100 enterprises stood at 66.1% in 2022, up 0.9%p from 2021.

☐ [Import]

The share of import value of top 10 enterprises stood at 33.7% in 2022, up 4.8%p from 2021. The share of import value of top 100 enterprises stood at 59.7% in 2022, up 4.9%p from 2021.
