<Economically active population and labor force participation rate>

- The economically active population marked 29.375 million persons in November, which grew 288 thousand persons or 1.0% year-on-year.
- The labor force participation rate stood at 64.6% in November, up 0.4%p year-on-year.

<Employed persons and employment to population ratio>

- The number of employed persons totaled 28.698 million persons in November, which went up 277 thousand persons or 1.0% year-on-year.
- The employment to population ratio recorded 63.1% in November, up 0.4%p year-on-year.

<Unemployed persons and unemployment rate>

- The number of unemployed persons totaled 677 thousand people in November, which increased 11 thousand persons or 1.7% year-on-year.
- The unemployment rate marked 2.3% in November, remaining the same year-on-year.

<Economically inactive population>

• The economically inactive population totaled 16.101 million people in November, decreasing 130 thousand persons or 0.8% year-on-year.
