



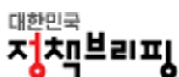

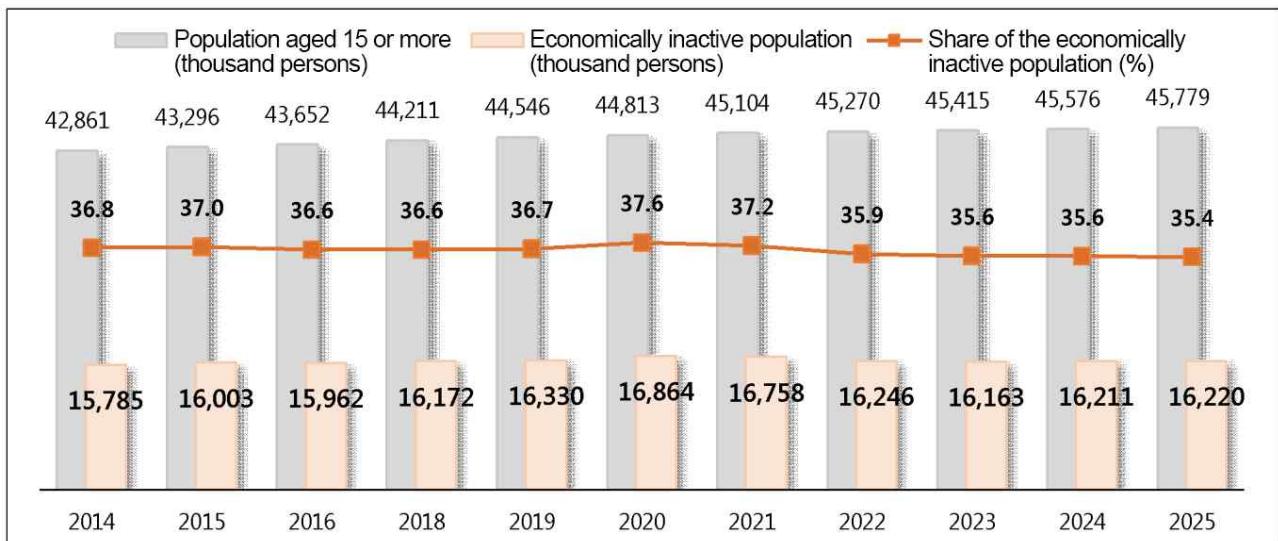

Supplementary Results of the Economically Active Population Survey for the Economically Inactive Population in August 2025

- In August 2025, the economically inactive population was 16.22 million persons, which grew by 9 thousand persons from August 2024. The economically inactive population occupied 35.4% of the population aged 15 or more, which dropped by 0.2%p from August 2024.

※ Survey reference period: Every August

- As for the economically inactive population by gender, females occupied 61.7% of the total economically inactive population, which was higher than males (38.3%). As for the economically inactive population by age group, people aged 70 or more occupied the largest share at 28.1%, which was followed by those aged 60~69 (18.7%) and those aged 15~19 (12.9%).

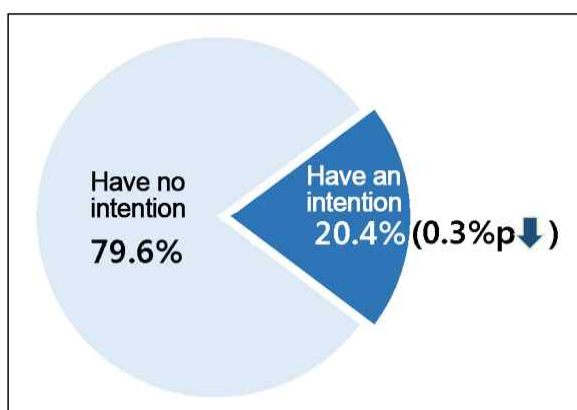

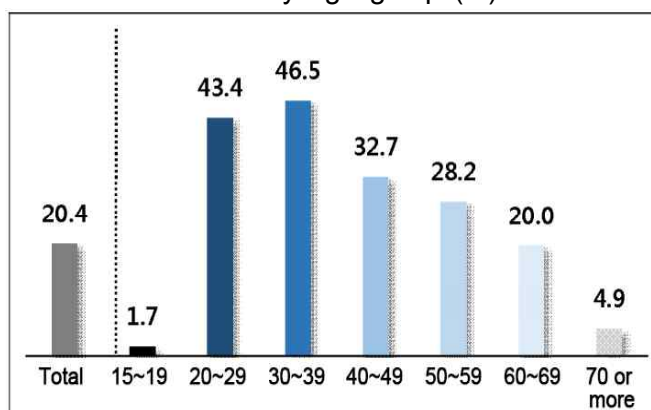

- The economically inactive population who wanted to get a job or establish a business within 1 year was 3.301 million persons, which accounted for 20.4% of the economically inactive population. This percentage went down by 0.3%p compared to August 2024.
- As for the share of the economically inactive population with the intention to get a job or establish a business by age group, people aged 30~39 showed the highest figure of 46.5%, which was followed by those aged 20~29 (43.4%), those aged 40~49 (32.7%) and those aged 50~59 (28.2%).

< Intention to get a job or establish a business within 1 year >



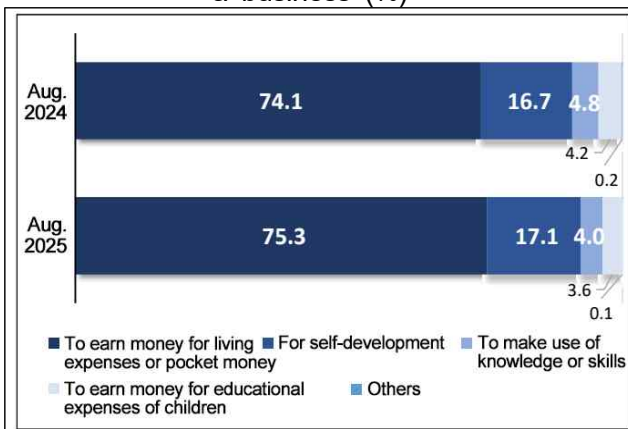
< Share of the economically inactive population with an intention to get a job or establish a business by age group (%) >



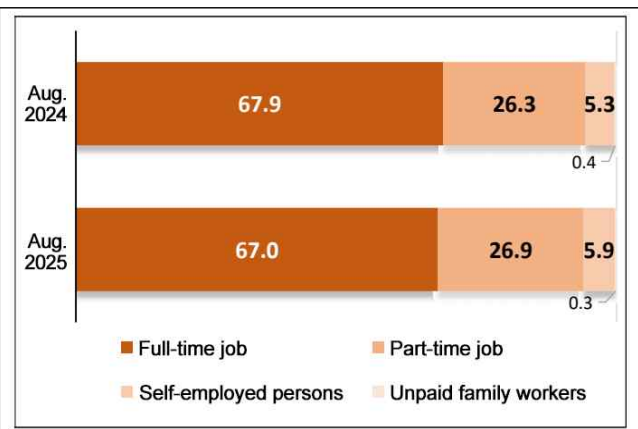
- Characteristics of the economically inactive population who wanted to get a job or establish a business within 1 year
- As for the reasons for getting a job or establishing a business, the largest share (75.3%) wanted to earn money for living expenses or pocket money.

- As for the employment type to be desired of the economically inactive population who wanted to get a job or establish a business within 1 year, 93.9% of them wanted to get a job as a wage worker. In the meantime, 6.2% of them wanted to get a job as a non-wage worker.
- As for the detailed employment type to be desired, 'Full-time job' occupied the largest share at 67.0%, which was followed by 'Part-time job' (26.9%), 'Self-employed person' (5.9%) and 'Unpaid family worker' (0.3%).
- As for the reasons for getting a part-time job, 'Due to health' occupied the largest share at 37.3%, which was followed by 'To carry out other things or activities side by side' (20.5%) and 'Child care and child education' (19.2%).

< Reasons for getting a job or establishing a business (%) >

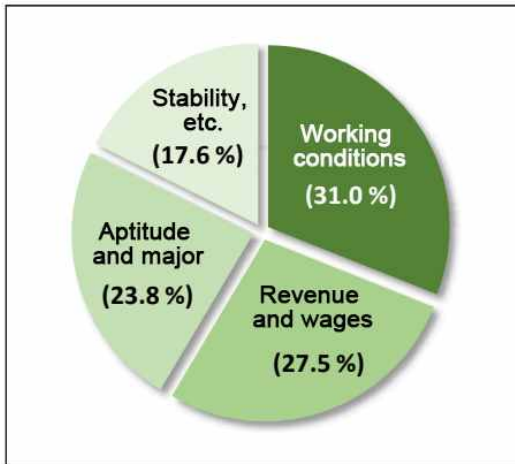


< Employment type to be desired (%) >

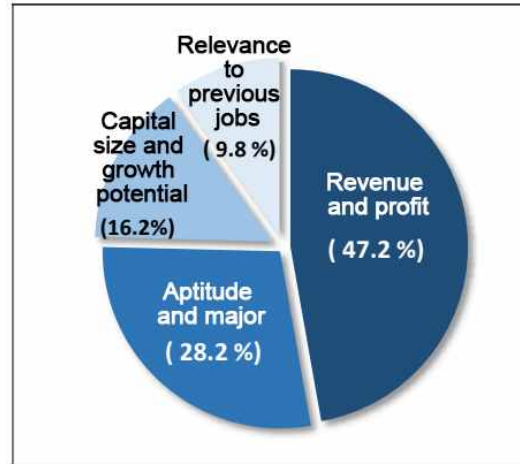


- As for the first priority to be considered when getting a job, the largest share (31.0%) of the economically inactive population who wanted to get a job as a wage worker considered 'Working conditions'. As for the first priority to be considered, the largest share (47.2%) of the economically inactive population who wanted to establish a business considered revenue and profit.
- As for the monthly average wages to be desired when getting a job, '2 million ~ less than 3 million won' occupied the largest share at 43.6%.
- As for the reasons for establishing a business, 'To utilize time freely' occupied the largest share at 32.6%.

- 79.6% of the economically inactive population had no intention to get a job or establish a business. This percentage rose by 0.3%p compared to August 2024.
- As for the reasons for having no intention to get a job or establish a business by gender, the largest share of males (33.5%) mentioned 'Commuting to (or attending) school or preparation for a higher education'. Whereas, the largest share of females (37.7%) mentioned 'House work'.
