
House Ownership Status in 2021

- Based on Administrative Data

1. House ownership status of individuals

- The house ownership individuals registered as employed amounted to 9.579 million persons in 2021. Among them, house ownership males and females occupied 60.6% and 39.4%, respectively.
- As for house ownership individuals by status of worker, wage workers amounted to 7.358 million persons, which occupied the largest share. Among wage workers, the share of house ownership males (60.6%) was higher than that of house ownership females (39.4%).

- The per-capita average ownership houses of non-wage workers stood at 1.25 units, which was higher than those of wage-workers (1.06 units).
- As for per-capita average ownership houses of wage workers by residence region, Jeonbuk, Chungnam and Gangwon recorded the highest figure of 1.10 units. As for per-capita average ownership houses of non-wage workers by residence region, Busan recorded the highest figure of 1.39 units.


< Per-capita average ownership houses by residence region (unit) (2021) >



2. House ownership status of households


- The percentage of house ownership households of non-wage workers stood at 69.2%, which was higher than that of house ownership households of wage workers (56.3%).
- As for the percentage of house ownership households of wage workers by region, Ulsan recorded the highest figure of 66.9%, which was followed by Gyeongnam (63.8%). Seoul recorded the lowest figure of 47.9%, which was followed by Jeju (53.7%).
- As for the percentage of house ownership households of non-wage workers by region, Gyeongnam recorded the highest figure of 73.9%, which was followed by Gyeongbuk (72.7%). Sejong recorded the lowest figure of 59.0%, which was followed by Seoul (65.8%).

- Among house ownership married households, the percentage of dual income house ownership households stood at 75.6%, which was higher than that of single income house ownership households (73.9%).
- Among the total house ownership households, households with a child aged less than 18 stood at 25.3%. The percentage of house ownership households with a child aged less than 18 stood at 66.1%, which was higher than that of house ownership households without a child aged less than 18 (53.5%).
- As for the number of house ownership households with a child aged less than 18 by age of household head, household heads aged 40~49 recorded the highest figure. As for the percentage of house ownership households with a child aged less than 18 by age of household head, household heads aged 60 or more recorded the highest figure of 78.3%.

* Refers to households whose head lives with a child aged less than 18. Also includes households whose head is not a parent of a child aged less than 18
