## Internal Migration in July 2023


- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 482 thousand persons in July 2023, which rose by 4.9% year-on-year.
- ☐ In July 2023, the internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 11.1%, which went up by 0.5%p year-on-year.

## 1. Internal migration

- ☐ The number of internal migrants was 482 thousand persons in July 2023, rising by 4.9% (23 thousand persons) year-on-year.
- ☐ The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants accounted for 66.4% and 33.6% of the total internal migrants in July 2023, respectively.
  - O Compared to July 2022, the intra-province migrants grew by 7.6%. The inter-province migrants remained the same year-on-year.

☐ The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 11.1%, up 0.5%p year-on-year.



## 2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 5 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Gyeonggi (3,499 persons), Incheon (2,906 persons), Chungnam (823 persons), etc. On the other hand, 12 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Seoul (-2,692 persons), Gyeongnam (-1,105 persons), Busan (-1,068 persons) and so on.
- □ Incheon, Chungbuk and Chungnam recorded a plus net migration rate of 1.2%, 0.5% and 0.5%, respectively. On the other hand, Ulsan, Gyeongnam and Jeonnam recorded a minus net migration rate of -0.6%, -0.4% and -0.4%, respectively.
