

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Internal Migration in January 2024

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
The number of internal migrants was 597 thousand persons in January 2024, which grew by 18.0% year-on-year.

□ In January 2024, the internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 13.8%, which went up by 2.2%p year-on-year.

< Internal migration for the past 3 years >

1. Internal migration

- □ The number of internal migrants was 597 thousand persons in January 2024, rising by 18.0% (91 thousand persons) year-on-year.
- ☐ The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants occupied 63.0% and 37.0% of the total internal migrants in January 2024, respectively.
 - O Compared to January 2023, the intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants grew by 21.3% and 12.7%, respectively.


□ The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 13.8%, up 2.2%p year-on-year.

[Figure 1] Internal migration in January


2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- □ Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 4 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Gyeonggi (4,954 persons), Incheon (3,373 persons), Chungnam (1,258 persons), etc. On the other hand, 13 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Gyeongbuk (-1,412 persons), Gyeongnam (-1,173 persons), Busan (-1,063 persons) and so on.
- □ Incheon, Sejong and Chungnam recorded a plus net migration rate of 1.3%, 0.9% and 0.7%, respectively. On the other hand, Jeju, Gyeongbuk and Chungbuk recorded a minus net migration rate of -1.3%, -0.7% and -0.6%, respectively.
