
Price Indices of Commodities Received and Paid by Farmers in 2016

Trends in the price indices of commodities received by farmers

1. Price index of all commodities received by farmers


- ☐ In 2016, the price index of all commodities received by farmers was 113.4 (2010 = 100), down 0.4 percent from 2015.
 - Price indices: 113.8 in 2015 ⇒ 113.4 in 2016
 - The price index of all commodities received by farmers went down by 0.4 percent from the previous year due to the drop in grains (-9.4%) in spite of the rise in livestock products (5.8%) and fruits and vegetables (1.9%).

< Year-on-year percent changes in the price index of commodities received by farmers >




2. Grains

- ☐ The price index of grains fell by 9.4 percent from the previous year due to the drop in rice (-11.2%) and potatoes (-6.1%) despite the rise in pulses & other cereals (10.3%) and barley (1.9%).
 - < Year-on-year percent changes in the price index of grains >




3. Fruits and vegetables

- ☐ The price index of fruits and vegetables rose by 1.9 percent from the previous year owing to the increase in vegetables (4.0%) despite the decrease in fruits (-0.8%).

4. Livestock products


- ☐ The price index of livestock products rose by 5.8 percent from the previous year owing to the rise in livestock (11.1%) despite the drop in milk & eggs (-7.4%).
 - < Year-on-year percent changes in the price index of livestock products >



5. Other farm products

☐ The price index of other farm products dropped by 1.9 percent from the previous year owing to the decrease in special crops (-2.7%) despite the increase in floriculture (1.4%).

< Year-on-year percent changes in the price index of other farm products >




$\ \ \, \square \ \ \,$ Trends in the price indices of commodities paid by farmers

1. Price index of all commodities paid by farmers

- \square In 2016, the price index of all commodities paid by farmers was 109.3 (2010 = 100), up 0.3 percent from 2015.
 - Price indices: 109.0 in 2015 ⇒ 109.3 in 2016
- The price index of all commodities paid by farmers went up by 0.3 percent from the previous year due to the rise in farm wages & charges (4.2%) and household goods (1.1%) in spite of the drop in farm supplies (-1.6%).


< Year-on-year percent changes in the price index of commodities paid by farmers >




2. Indices by item

□ The price index of household goods rose by 1.1 percent owing to the increase in food and non-alcoholic beverages (3.1%) and restaurants and hotels (2.5%) despite the decrease in housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels (-3.0%) and transport (-2.1%).

< Year-on-year percent changes in the price index of household goods >




- □ The price index of farm supplies fell by 1.6 percent owing to the drop in fertilizers (-20.7%) and agricultural lighting and heating expenditures (-16.8%) despite the rise in livestock (20.3%).

☐ The price index of farm wages and charges rose by 4.2 percent owing to the increase in agricultural labor wages (4.3%) and rent on farming machines (0.9%).

III Terms of trade index for farm households

 \square In 2016, the terms of trade index for farm households recorded 103.7 (2010 = 100), down 0.7 percent from 2015.


- Price indices: 104.4 in 2015 ⇒ 103.7 in 2016
- The terms of trade index for farm households declined by 0.7 percent from the previous year owing to the drop in the price index of all commodities received by farmers (-0.4%) despite the rise in the price index of all commodities paid by farmers (0.3%).
